Doug Zipay made a motion to have our landscaper review the situation and supply us with alternatives.

A motion was made to discuss the need for residents to be aware that as the homes ageing, re-painting will be necessary.

Discussion- A discussion ensued as to how to advise the Homeowners that as the homes get older, they will need to be maintained and re-painted in accordance with our Docs. A suggestion was made to send a general mailer to all Homeowners stating that the Docs require all homes to be maintained in an appropriate manner, as paint is usually only warranted for about 7 years and all homes in the Association are approaching or have eclipsed the 7-year recommendation. Doug Zipay made a motion to send all Homeowners a letter re-iterating he need to maintain all homes and re-paint as necessary to conform to the Association Docs.
